

Luddenden Dean Wesleyan Methodist Chapel – Burial Register 2 (1874-c.1914)

Information regarding burials in the burial ground at Luddenden Dean Wesleyan Methodist Chapel is provided in the following order:

- Simplified plan of the relevant section of the burial ground applicable to Burial Register 2
- Index of surnames as listed in Burial Register 2
- Index of places as listed in Burial Register 2
- Information from Burial Register 2

Within this register burial plot purchases were referred to as graves.

Each grave was allocated a number – from 1 to 200. All numbered graves from 1 to 198 lie east of the former chapel. However number 199 and 200 lie to the west – these particular plots were also renumbered and recorded in Burial Register 3 as grave number 1 and 2.

In the information provided here a reference has been made to the status of the plot ie. the existence or non existence of a monumental inscription (MI). If a monumental inscription does exist it is noted as *MI*. If not, then the term *unmarked* is used. Similarly where a burial plot was purchased, but not used, then the term *unused* is applied. These references are to be found directly under the grave number on the left hand side of the page.

Calderdale Family History Society has published a database for all of the monumental inscriptions (MI's) at Luddenden Dean Wesleyan Methodist Chapel.

A comparison of this MI data with information in Burial Register 2 reveals that there is not always an identical match. There may be either a name omission or a name addition.

On the one hand a monumental inscription may not include the names of all those buried in the plot. On the other hand a monumental inscription may have included an additional name - the name of a person not actually buried there eg. war dead or those lost at sea.
